'DISCRIMINATORY PRICING' CCI orders probe into Star India's alleged abuse of dominant position

THE COMPETITION COMMISSION if India (CCI) has directed its investigation arm to initiate a probe into alleged abuse of dominant position by Star India.

The order came on a complaint filed by Asianet Digital Network (P) against Star India, Disney Broadcasting (India) and Asianet Star Communications. According to the complaint, Star India was providing a bouquet of channels to the competitor of the informant at lesser prices, resulting in denial of market access and also amounting to unfair/discriminatory pricing.

It chose an indirect way to provide these discounts to circumvent the New Regulatory Framework of TRAI by way of promotion and advertisement payments to the informant's competitor through high valued advertising deals, the complaint alleged.

"Therefore, on the basis of market share, dependence of consumers, size and resources of the enterprise (being part of global media conglomerate), vertical integration of the enterprise and countervailing power, the Commission is of prima facie view that OP-1 enjoy a position of dominance in the relevant market delineated



supra," the commission said.

The relevant market prima facie appears to be "market for provision of broadcasting services in the State of Kerala", it said. OP-1 refers to Star India.

The alleged price discrimination between different multi-system operators of Star India has resulted in significant loss in consumer base to the informant and therefore prima facie appears to be in violation of the provisions of Section 4 of the Competition Act, the regulator said. Section 4 pertains to abuse of dominant position.

"Accordingly, the Commission directs the Director General (DG) to cause an investigation to be made into the matter and submit an investigation report within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of this order," the CCI

said in an order dated February 28. It said nothing in this order shall be tantamount to a final expression of opinion on the merits of the case, and the DG shall conduct the investigation without being swayed by the observations.

Separately, the regulator has dismissed a plea of interim relief filed by the informant.

CCI disposes of complaint against Amazon Seller Services, others

March 4: The Competition Commission has disposed of a complaint alleging unfair business practices by Amazon Seller Services and other related entities, saying that the allegations are devoid of requisite evidence.

The complaint was filed by All India Online Vendors Association against Amazon Seller Services, Amazon Wholesale India, Amazon Retail India, Cloudtail India and Prone Business Services. The association comprises more than 2,000 sellers, with its members selling products on e-commerce marketplaces.

The association said there are anti-competitive arrangements amongst the entities, resulting in alleged lack of platform neutrality on Amazon.in.
